TSCA Lesson Grant Information/Requirements:

- 1. Clubs that receive lessons grants are at the discretion of the TSCA Board.
- 2. Grants are a maximum of \$250.00.
- 3. The Club must be located in and conduct dances/lessons in Texas.
- 4. Application for a grant in no way obligates TSCA to award a grant to the applicant.
- 5. Application for a grant must be submitted after lessons have been completed.
- 6. Lessons instructors must be a member of the Texas State Callers' Association (TSCA).
- 7. Lessons must cover ALL the calls on the CALLERLAB Mainstream Program. (Exception: If the applying club is a "Basic" level club, lessons must cover ALL the calls on the CALLERLAB Basic Program.)
- 8. Clubs seeking a lesson grant should start lessons with 8 students and must graduate at least 5 to be eligible. (A student is defined as a person who has paid for the lessons. A graduate is defined as a person who has paid for/and completed the lessons.)
- 9. For grant approval the optimum hours for mainstream lessons is 40 hours, and for basic lessons, 28 hours. The Board will consider all applicants and review the applicants' supporting documentation for approval on any reasonable amount of lesson time.
- 10. Clubs receiving grants are not eligible to reapply until 2 years after receiving the grant.
